The proposal may not exceed the space on this sheet (front and back). It may be double- or singled-spaced, but may not be smaller than 12-point type, with margins no less than one inch.

The project proposal should be a statement describing the research, study, or internship that you propose to pursue. You should substantiate your proposal with any academic or professional background relevant to conducting your project. This might include: prior language study, previous travel or study in the region, academic work or work experience, and any publications or presentations you have made. If you are applying to participate in an experience (internship, research, seminar, clinical rotation) that has a pre-arranged curriculum or itinerary, please indicate the name of the agency or institution that will be the sponsor and specify how the experience fits into your degree program. If you are designing your own research study or internship, describe the background and qualifications that are required and how you meet those.
